




Data is beginning to level out.


UCR Trends


Data reported following same trend, more accurate picture.







Improvements based on feedback.

- Pre-Audit Guide/Training sent out 90 days before Audit starts
- 90 Day Audit Cycle
- UCR staff's role in your audit
- Follow Up

FBI UCR Audit Findings

70 agencies provided 150 incidents.

29 incidents flagged with issues = 19.3%

35B	Assaults	Thefts
Underreporting Drug Equipment	Reported Inaccurately	Inaccurate Reporting 240/23F
Linked to Vape Pens	Charging vs Reporting	Thefts are getting reported when it should be reported as something different
Both liquid and pen need to be reported	Assault Infographic	Ex. Theft From Motor Vehicle should be Con Games or Motor Vehicle Theft
35A in DU for liquid; 35B for device	Weapon, Injury, Intent	Simplify the situation to help
